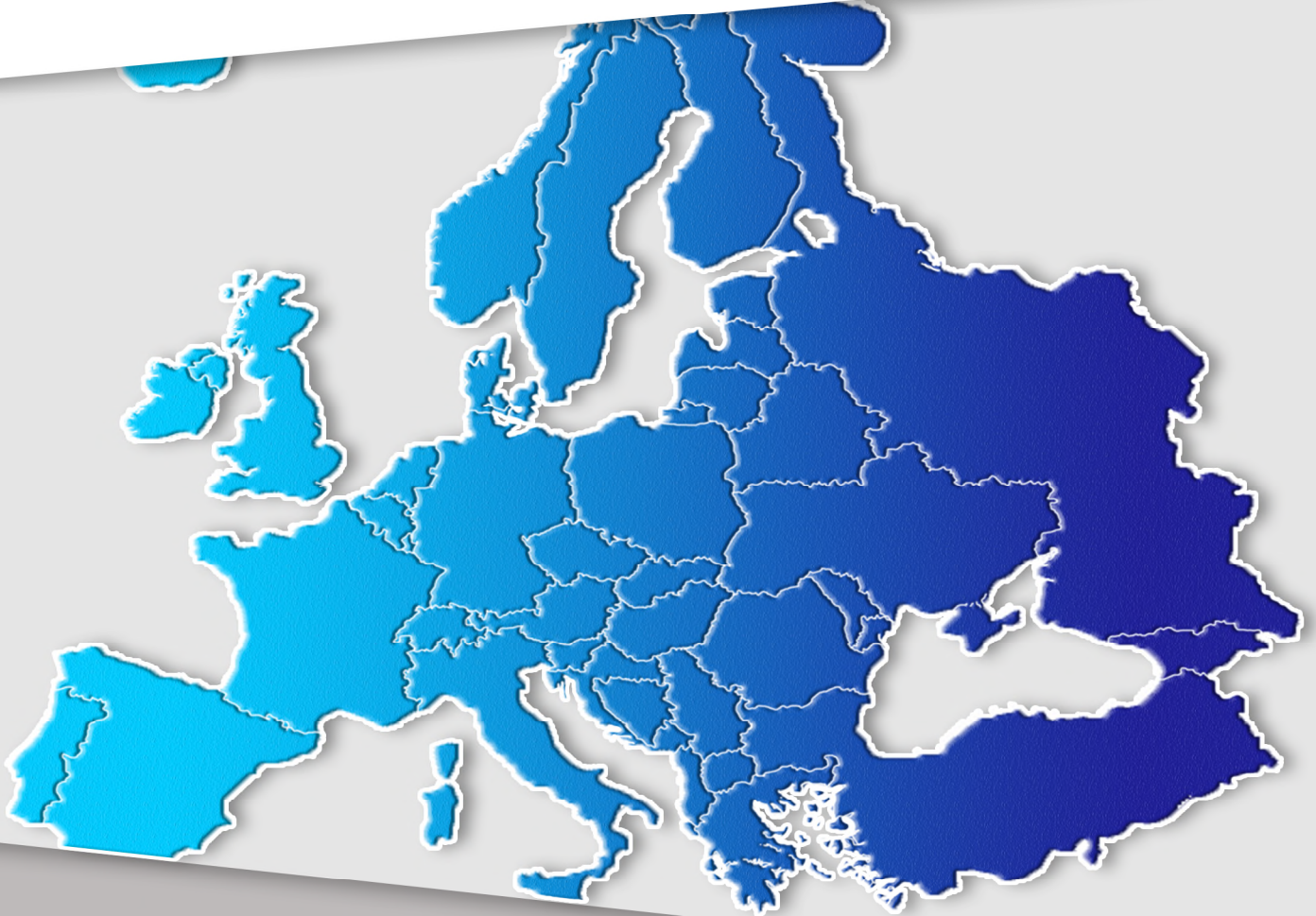

SPRINKLER NETWORK

Fire kills over 4000 people a year. It also causes over €10 billion in property loss and environmental damage. Most of these losses could be prevented by the widespread installation of fire sprinklers. Cities with widely installed sprinklers have seen fire injuries and property losses fall by over 80%, and fire deaths eradicated. This forward thinking needs to be exemplary to the whole of Europe. The European Fire Sprinkler Network was formed in 2002 as a not for profit organisation to spread this message. The EFSN promote the installation of fire sprinklers and the like throughout Europe. It also promotes high standards of professionalism within the fire sprinkler industry.

MEMBERSHIP

The EFSN offer a membership that will bring you in contact with the growing European movement calling for widespread installation of automatic fire suppression systems. OUR AIMS

Establish and connect a network of Europeans with a common interest in better fire protection through the fitting of sprinklers.

Promote fire sprinkler legislation in the EU and EEA states.

Encourage research into the real costs of fire and the effectiveness of fire sprinkler systems.

Support training programmes and the application of fire sprinkler standards to encourage best practice in the fire sprinkler industry.

Encourage individuals and organisations to join the coalition, helping it to increase visibility and influence.

MEMBERSHIP CATEGORIES

Insurer – A company that insures against fire death, injury, property or commercial losses.

Authority having jurisdiction – A body that approves a building for fire safety, such as a fire service or local government inspector.

Contractor/non-sprinkler manufacturer – A company engaged in water-based fire protection contracting or a manufacturer of products other than sprinklers for these systems.

Sprinkler manufacturer – A company that manufactures fire sprinklers or water mist nozzles.

Distributor – A company not qualifying as a contractor or manufacturer and that distributes components for water-based fire protection systems.

Professional/Certification Body – A company which does not qualify as a contractor, manufacturer or distributor and that provides design services, specifications or certifications for water-based fire protection systems.

Individual and all other members – An individual who supports the aims of the Network but who does not qualify in prior mentioned categories.
